## BOND PROPOSALS 2010

Voters decided 17 state-level bond propositions in 6 states in 2010, approving 15 of them for a total of \$2.0 billion, and rejecting 2 that would have borrowed \$660 million. This report provides a complete list of state-level bond proposals in 2010. In comparison, in 2008 voters approved 14 of 15 bond propositions, authorizing more than \$13 billion.
