

INITIATIVE USE

February 2017

A total of 2,547 state-level initiatives have been on the ballot since the first ones went before the voters in Oregon in 1904, and 1,048 (41 percent) have been approved.

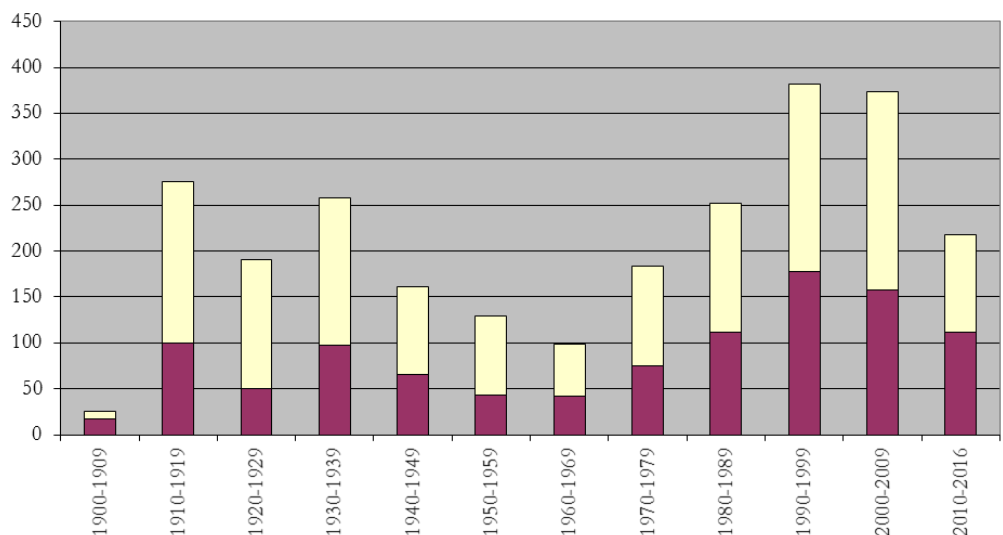
The modern initiative movement began in the late 1970s with California's tax-cutting Proposition 13. Initiative use exploded in the following decades, reaching a peak of 382 in the 1990s, 178 of which were approved. The first decade of the new century saw a total of 374 initiatives, with 158 passing.

Twenty-four states have had at least one initiative during the period 1904-2016. California and Oregon are tied for the most, with 371 initiatives, and they have an identical 35 percent approval rate. Colorado (231), North Dakota (195), and Washington (182) round out the top five.

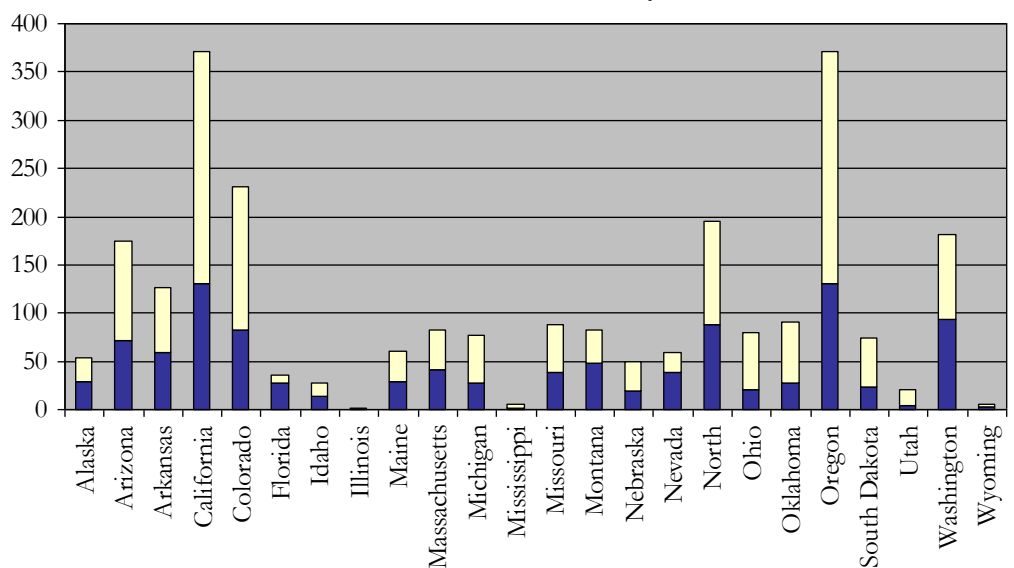
